### DID YOU KNOW?

- 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC provides academic enrichment during non-school hours for children.<sup>1</sup>
- Supports students who attend high-poverty and low-performing schools.
- Faith-based Organizations and Community-based Organizations may be eligible to receive grants if they meet all requirements<sup>2</sup>
- 21st CCLC programs partner with 1 in 5 CBO and FBO<sup>3</sup>
- Funds support tutoring services and mentoring programs.<sup>4</sup>
