Federal Register Notices of Interest

- State Reporting Requirements
 - Thursday, January 25th; Page 3698
 - Revised 34 CFR 76.720
- States must comply with the Secretary's requirements regarding submission
- If a state doesn't submit reports in the manner required, will constitute substantial noncompliance

Federal Register Notices of Interest

- Any sanctions will be considered on a case-by-case basis
- Secretary can establish a transition period for electronic submissions
- A state may require a subgrantee to submit reports in a specific manner to assist the state in complying with these requirements

Federal Register Notices of Interest

- Technical Assistance on Data Collection
 - Friday, January 26th, Page 3809
 - Notice of Proposed Priority (NPP) (Invitation to comment)
 - Comments due by April 11th
 - Final priority will be announced in the Federal Register after consideration of comments on this NPP

Federal Register Notices of Interest

- Provide TA and information to states to help them provide high quality data needed for implementation of Parts B and C and improve their data collection infrastructures
- Provide assistance to the Department regarding these data collections
