COPS Hiring Program

Amount Available in FY15: \$134.5 million

- The Fiscal Year 2016 COPS Hiring Program (CHP) will open by May;
- CHP grants provide up to 75 percent of the approved entry-level salaries and fringe benefits of each newly hired and/or rehired full-time officer, with a minimum 25 percent local cash match requirement and a maximum federal share of \$125,000 per officer position, over the three-year (36-month) grant period.
- The FY2016 CHP grant program is an open solicitation. All local, state, and tribal law enforcement agencies that have primary law enforcement authority are eligible to apply.

Amount Available in FY 15: \$7.5 million
