### ELIGIBILITY

Participants must be U.S. citizens who are university or community college students that plan to graduate with a Bachelor's degree by May 2025 or May 2026.

Applications from non-traditional students from historically underrepresented groups, such as first-generation and low-income, are encouraged to apply.

Applicants should have an interest in international affairs and democracy. Only 20 students will be selected to participate.

This program covers airfare, ground transportation, accommodations, meals and a \$500 stipend.
